About the Basic Rider Course 2

The **Basic Rider Course 2** was developed by the **Motorcycle Safety Foundation** as a skill-polishing course for riders with at least three months riding experience. The workshop consists of approximately five hours of instruction all taught by **MSF Certified Rider Coaches**. The on range classroom session covers: risk management, the relationship between mental and physical riding skills, traction management and developing a riding strategy. Through the hands on riding, you'll practice proper braking techniques: straight line stops, stopping on curves, rapid stops (both straight line and in curves), counter steering for swerving, counter steering for cornering and the use of counterbalancing skills for tighter turns. The exercises combine to provide an understanding of motorcycle dynamics.

Upon satisfactory completion of the **BRC2** you will receive a **Motorcycle Safety Foundation** Course completion card entitling you to a discount with most insurance companies. All riders must provide their own motorcycle, full tank of gas, proof of registration and insurance and present their motorcycle license. All motorcycles must pass a routine pre-ride inspection and the **Rider Coaches** safety check. Students must have a current NY State motorcycle inspection. Riders are required to wear proper riding gear: over the ankle-boots, full-fingered gloves, long sleeve jacket, D.O.T. approved helmet and eye protection for all riding exercises.

The **BRC2** Classroom/Riding sessions are conducted on the range. Failure to have proper riding gear, failure to be prepared to ride, (late, impaired motorcycle not available or unsafe) will result in dismissal from the course and the cancellation policy will apply.

Course Payment

Payment in full is required with this signed application. The course fee is \$125.00, which can be made payable in cash, check or money order. (keep in mind, we **DO NOT** accept credit or debit cards.)

Course Cancellation Policy

(Read Carefully)

There is a non-refundable \$10.00 processing fee. **Trama's Auto School Inc.**, must receive one week's notice to cancel or to reschedule. If you cancel or reschedule with less than one week's notice (7 days) of your scheduled course date you will forfeit \$50 of course fee. In case of inclement weather, riders will be notified the day prior to course date (\$10.00 non-refundable processing fee will **STILL** apply.)

If you fail to show up on the day of your course, are unprepared to ride (improper riding gear, late, impaired, no bike, etc.) or fail to provide the documents listed above, you will forfeit the entire course fee. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS. There will be no make-ups or refunds for absences.**

Physical Requirements

I understand that, riding a motorcycle requires alertness, coordination, balance, grip and fine muscle control of the hands and feet. Certain medical conditions, recent surgery or injury and/or certain prescription or over-the-counter drugs may interfere with safe motorcycle operation. If you have a history of dizzy spells, fainting, seizures, epilepsy, muscular, balance/inner ear or other physical or stress related problems, are recovering from recent injury or surgery and/or are taking prescription or

over-the-counter medications, it is imperative that you consult with your doctor or pharmacist before the course to determine if your medical condition, or the drugs that you are taking for it, could interfere with your ability to operate a motorcycle.

The undersigned hereby acknowledges that breach of this contract will result in a lost opportunity for **Trama's Auto School Inc.** and the liquidated damages for such shall be all or part of the course fee depending on when notice of cancellation/rescheduling is given as outlined here in.
