About The Advanced Rider Course (ARC)

The **Advance Rider course** is the public version of the military sport bike RiderCourse (MSRC) and may be taken by riders using any type of motorcycle. It is a one day course consisting of approximately 3 1/2 hours of classroom activities and 4 1/2 hours of riding. There are eight riding exercises which include

- (1) Basic control , (2) Quick stops,
- (3) Stopping demonstration, (4) Curve adjustments, (5)cornering and swerving,
- (6)multiple curves, (7)decreasing Radius curves
- (8)Gap analysis and safely margins.

There is no formal skill test but there is a knowledge test that may be self scored. The class size is 12 riders and 2 certified rider coaches.

This course will provide the rider development in the areas of risk management, decision making riding strategies and rider behavior and choices. This includes learner activities in knowledge, skill altitude values and habits. The procedures for riding a sports bike do not vary greatly from the procedures for riding other types of motorcycles. But the techniques some riders use are different and these depend somewhat on the specific motorcycle as well as the specific talent and skill level of a rider.

Techniques that extend beyond basic riding procedures are addressed in the ARC. Sport bike riding techniques are not intended to encourage or endorse riding at higher speeds but are provided to improve the performance capabilities of riders, particularly related to overall control, cornering and emergency maneuvers. Which include two finger braking, balls of feet on footrests, use of leg pressure for control etc.

Course Payment

Payment in full is required with this signed application. The course fee is \$155.00, which can be made payable in cash, check or money order. (keep in mind we **DO NOT** accept credit or debt cards)

Course Cancellation Policy (Read Carefully)

There is a non-refundable \$10.00 processing fee. **Trama's Auto School Inc.**, must receive one week's notice to cancel or to reschedule. If you cancel or reschedule with less than one week's notice (7 days) of your scheduled course date you will forfeit \$55 of course fee. In case of inclement weather, riders will be notified the day prior to course date (\$10.00 non-refundable processing fee will *STILL* apply.)If you fail to show up on the day of your course, are unprepared to ride (improper riding gear, late, impaired, no bike, etc.) or fail to pass our instructors pre-course inspection/safety check, you will forfeit the entire course fee. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS. There will be no refunds or make ups for absences.** Also make sure your motorcycle is in good working conditions and has a full tank of gas. You are responsible for the mechanical condition of your motorcycle. If you are unable to participate in the course because of mechanical problems it will qualify as a cancelation and the cancelation policy will apply.

Physical Requirements

I understand that, riding a motorcycle requires alertness, coordination, balance, grip and fine muscle control of the hands and feet. Certain medical conditions, recent surgery or injury and/or certain prescription or over-the-counter drugs may interfere with safe motorcycle operation. If you have a history of dizzy spells, fainting, seizures, epilepsy, muscular, balance/inner ear or other physical or stress related problems, are recovering from recent injury or surgery and/or are taking prescription or over-the-counter medications, it is imperative that you consult with your doctor or pharmacist before the course to determine if your medical condition, or the drugs that you are taking for it, could interfere with your ability to operate a motorcycle.

The undersigned hereby acknowledges that breach of this contract will result in a lost opportunity for **Trama's Auto School Inc.** and the liquidated damages for such shall be all or part of the course fee depending on when notice of cancellation/rescheduling is given as outlined here in.
